- 1. Be a resident of Descanso in the 91916 zip code area or live between Riverside Dr. and I-8 (need to provide proof)
- 2. Be a graduating senior this year
- 3. Have a grade point average of 3.0 (Need to submit transcript)
- 4. Are planning to attend a community college or university in the fall of 2021.
- 5. Need 2 letters of recommendation: one from a teacher and one from an adult you have known for several years, not a family member.
- 6. You must submit a **500 word** essay to include: Reason for attending college, the lifetime values that you hope to receive by attending college, what you would like to choose as your major and why, and where you would like to see yourself in 5 years regarding education and job opportunities.

No name please. All essays will be assigned a number and judged by an impartial committee. Essays must by typed.

#### Format for Essay:

- I. Title
- II. Introduction paragraph
- III. Body paragraphs
- IV.. Conclusion paragraph

Spelling and grammar will count. There will also be an oral interview by the scholarship committee. There will be 5 questions asked of each applicant.

## Molly Jean Featheringill

It was in August 1984, that Molly Jean moved to her family's cabin in Descanso to take up permanent residence.
